**Please read the following important message from our school nurse, Mrs. Kochanek.**

There has been a higher than normal increase in the number of students who have been diagnosed with strep throat the past 2 weeks, with the majority of the cases in 2nd grade. If your child complains of a sore throat with fever and stomachache, please consider taking your child to the doctor for a strep test. If the fast strep test is negative, please keep your child home until your doctor calls with the results of the overnight or 48 hour strep test. Please do not send your child back to school until he/she is fever free for 24 hours. Thank you for your consideration of this matter. Strep is highly contagious and we are trying to prevent a major outbreak throughout the school.
