### DID YOU KNOW...

- ◆ Boys and girls had separate line up spots and entered the school from opposite sides. You can still see the word "GIRLS" above the door by the upper blacktop area.
- ◆ The wall dividing 1A and 1D was a collapsible wall that was often opened up to allow for large group activities.
- ◆ On cold winter days, kindergarten children would warm their bodies in front of the fireplace in what is now Mrs. Auxter's room. Stop by to see the original tiles around the fireplace.
- ◆ The first "new addition" to Coolidge School took place during the late 1940's. The current classrooms of 2D, 2M, guidance office, music room and 5B were part of this addition.
