- ◆ The principal's office served as Coolidge School's first library. This was not used as a library as we know it today, but rather simply a place that housed books. Mrs. Borelli's office was Coolidge School's second library. In fact, the words "library" are still written on her door.
- ◆ Fifth grade students, if they were well-behaved, were given the privilege of lighting the stove in the teacher's room before lunch so the teachers would be able to have tea. By the way, the teacher's room is in the exact location and is the exact size as it was in 1932!
