Dear Parents and Guardians,

Spring has finally arrived and the weather has improved. There are many events going on throughout the schools to enjoy including concerts, art shows, plays, sports, and other special events. Please enjoy your children participating in these events throughout the remainder of the school year.

CALENDAR CHANGE:

Please note that the Board of Education, during the May 12, 2008 meeting, revised the 2007-2008 School District Calendar so that all Eisenhower students in grades 6-8 will have a minimum day on Thursday, June 19. Eighth grade students will be participating in a promotional ceremony that evening.

Please note the following changes for the remainder of the current school year:

- Friday, May 23, 2008 Schools will be closed
- Thursday, June 19, 2008 Eisenhower School Grades 6-8 will have a minimum day. All Elementary Schools will have a regular day of school.
- Friday, June 20, 2008 Last day and minimum day for all students

ASSISTANCE PLEASE:

This is the time of year when we start to determine exactly how many books and materials, desks and chairs, and paper and pencils will be needed for every classroom in September. It would be very helpful to know if you are planning to relocate to another school next year. If you are, please let your building principal know as soon as possible. In addition, if you know of a family re-locating to Wyckoff, ask them to contact the principal as well. This will assist us in using taxpayer funds effectively and efficiently in planning for the next school year.

RESIDENCY ISSUES:

The Board of Education takes the education of our students and its responsibility to all taxpayers very seriously. This year we experienced a few residency issues where children were found to be attending our schools, but not actually living within Wyckoff Township. The Board of Education does follow through on these incidents; tuition is charged and students are transferred to their proper school district. Sometimes this process takes some time, but please know that the Board of Education and your Superintendent do follow through and complete the process. We ask your assistance in reporting potential residency issues to the Superintendent of Schools. If you believe someone is sending their children to district schools and they do not reside within Wyckoff Township, please notify the Superintendent with the name of the family and reasons why you believe they do not reside in town.
