Nicaragua



According to the World Bank, as cited by USAID, Nicaragua has an average per capita annual income of \$430. The UN's World Food Program estimates the per capita income lower still, at \$300. **Half the population lives on less than a dollar a day.** On the Atlantic Coast, the figure is three quarters of the population.
