

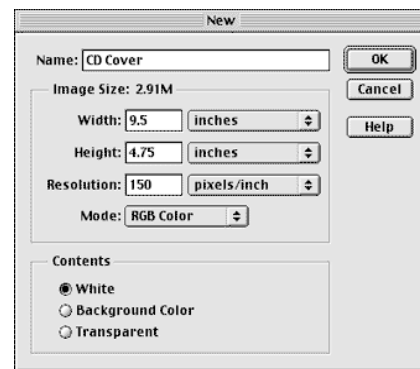
CD Jewel Case Cover



1. Open Photoshop Elements.

2. Go to the File Menu and select New...

3. You will get a dialog box like the one shown on the right.



4. Enter **9.5 inches** as the width, **4.75 inches** as the height and **150 pixels/inch** as the resolution. Make sure that the width and height are being measured in inches and the resolution is pixels/inch. You may also put CD Cover in the name box; this titles your document. In the Contents box select **White**.

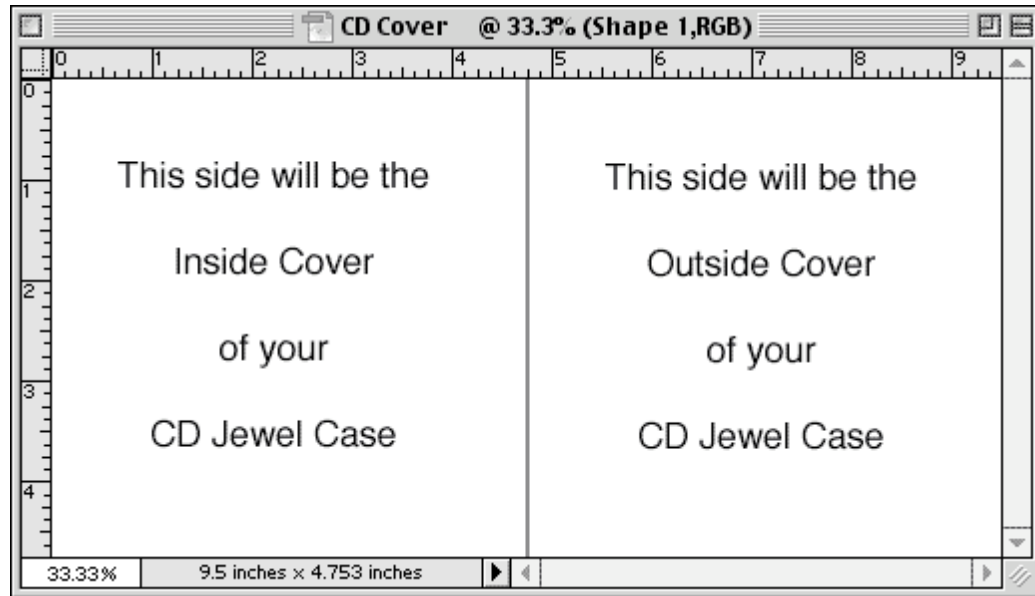
5. When your dialog box looks like the above box click OK.

6. A new window will appear. Check to see if you have a ruler going across the top and down the left side of your new document. If a ruler is there go on to the next step. If not, you can make the rulers appear by going to the View menu and selecting Show Rulers.

7. Select the Brush Tool and find the middle of your canvas, 4.75 inches. Then draw a straight line down the middle of your canvas with a 3 pixel size brush. Hold the shift key down while

you use the brush tool for a straight line. This will show the front and inside sides of your CD insert.

8. The layout of your project should look like the image below without the text.



9. You are now ready to use all of the tools that Photoshop Elements offers to create your CD insert. You may want to start by using the gradient tool to put a background gradient on your CD cover. Paste images of your completed projects on your CD insert.

10. The CD insert should include:

- Your Name
- The Date
- Title - Digital Imaging

11. Be sure to use layer styles to highlight your text and images. You may also want to use Warp Text to distort your text. You will find Warp Text in the options palette when you have the text tool selected.
