

# Manipulated Photography Assignments

## Group 1 - Composite Images

### Images Composed of more than one Photograph

1. Disproportionate Photograph - Take one of your pictures and either change the scale of an object, objects or people in the picture. You may also use objects or people from other pictures.
2. Where am I? - Take a picture of a friend or have someone take a picture of you. Then, take another picture of a place that you would not expect to see a person. Put yourself or your friends in that surprising place.
3. Untruthful Photograph - Take a picture and add something to the picture that wasn't there.
4. Repetition - Take something from a picture and repeat it to create a new picture.
5. Photo Collage - Take many images or parts of images of the same thing or different things and combine them to create a new image.
6. Surrealism - An art movement started in Paris around 1924 based on ideas of expressing the unconscious. An aspect of this movement was to combine objects that had nothing to do with one another into one image. Create an image which combines two things that would not ordinarily go together.
7. Who's in school? - Take a picture of a school corridor or classroom and download images of famous people or cartoon characters and put them in the school. Be sure to download a large size image.
8. Art Additions - Select an appropriate work of art and add yourself or someone you know. You may simply add a person's head or place an entire person in a painting. Use the class links page to find an appropriate work of art. Be sure to credit the original artist and his or her work of art.
9. Scale - Enlarge or shrink a person or object in a picture

## Group 2 - Painted Images

### Images Altered with Paint & Drawing Tools

1. Colorize An Image - Take one of your pictures and use the brush, bucket and other tools to radically change the color of your picture.
2. Paint a New World - Keep the subject of your picture but remove the background and paint a new one. You can put your subject anywhere!
3. Black and White In Color - Take one of your pictures and turn it into a black and white image. Then, colorize the subject of the picture but leave the background black and white or, colorize the background and leave the subject in black and white.
4. Distorted Portrait - Take a portrait of someone and then distort the person's picture.
5. Art Additions - Visit a museum website and select and download an artwork. Draw or paint on the image. Be sure to download an image with a large file size, at least 100k, so that the image will print well.
6. Virtual Graffiti - Take a picture of the school and add your own virtual graffiti by drawing on the image.
7. Distorted Portrait - Take a portrait of someone and then distort the person's picture paint and drawing tools. Be sure to respect the rights and feelings of others. DO NOT CREATE A PICTURE THAT WILL HURT THE FEELINGS OF OTHERS.

## Group 3 - Filtered Images

### Images Altered Using Filters

1. Distorted Portrait - Take a portrait of someone and then distort the person's picture using filters. Be sure to respect the rights and feelings of others. DO NOT CREATE A PICTURE THAT WILL HURT THE FEELINGS OF OTHERS.
2. Transform an Image - Select one of your pictures and then experiment with Filters to transform the image. Use additional layers to apply different filters to the same image.
